Sarah's message

I wonder what things come to mind as you think about May? Some nice things – maypole dancing, May blossom, even 'gathering nuts in May'? Perhaps, some less nice – May bugs and May flies... Maybe your mind turns to political matters and the celebration of workers and workers rights on May Day? It could be you celebrate a month with two Bank Holidays!

However, May is also the month of two important dates in the Christian Calendar; Ascension Day and Pentecost (or Whitsun). Jesus spent 40 days after the resurrection meeting with his followers, reassuring them he was alive and giving them final instructions. The day he returned to the heavens and his Father is remembered each year on Ascension Day. As Jesus rose on a Sunday, Ascension Day is always on a Thursday. Some churches hold special services, but generally, most Baptist churches in the UK do not.

Ten days after that (Pentecost means 50 in Greek) the church celebrates the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the early disciples and the renewed power with which they spoke and acted. Jesus had told them he would ask the Father to send the Spirit and that they were to wait in Jerusalem until that happened. On the first day of Pentecost, they poured out into the street and miraculously, the whole crowd heard the disciples speaking in their own language. Peter got up and preached and though some mocked what was happening, that day, about 3000 people in Jerusalem came to faith in Jesus as the promised Messiah and as God incarnate. You can read all about this in Acts 2.

How amazing it is that the same Spirit who equipped and enabled the early disciples is still at work in the world and the church through us! Who might you gossip the gospel to as the Spirit enables you?
